- \* (HOT) **Caliente**.- it is used to describe the temperature of things.  
**Caluroso**.- it is used when you talk about the weather.  
**Tener calor**.- it is used when you say you're hot (temperature).
- \* (OLD) **Mayor**.- it is used for people.  
**Viejo(a)**.- it is used for things / animals.

**Note :** All adjectives will **always** be used **after** the nouns.

**Ejemplos :**

- Mi hermano esta muy sano y alegre ( My brother is very healthy and happy )
- Nuestro maestro es una persona agradable ( Our teacher is a nice person )
- Mi mama esta siempre ocupada ( My mom is always busy )
- El carro es grande y Viejo ( The car is big and old )
- Bill es un hombre delgado ( Bill is a thin man )
- Mi abuela es una mujer mayor ( My grandmother is an old woman )
